## **BEFORE O WEEK**

Visit the <b>New Students</b> website to finalise your enrolment at JCU - contact <b>enquiries@jcu.edu.au</b> if you require assistance.
Complete the <b>GetReady4Uni</b> modules. These modules are designed to assist you to transition successfully to university and it is also where you will find all your O Week information.
Verify your Current Enrolment is correct in <b>eStudent</b> under 'My Study Plan'.
Check if you are eligible for a HELP-Loan and please complete the Commonwealth Assistance forms by the Payment Due Date. To <b>defer payment of your subject fees</b> , log in to <b>eStudent</b> , click on the 'My Commonwealth Assistance' tab, and submit the relevant form(s). For more information on your fees, visit the <b>Fees and Financial Support</b> web page.
Register for classes (tutorials and workshops) in <b>eStudent</b> under 'My Timetable' to create your personalised timetable – please note some subjects have automatically allocated classes.
Order your <b>Student ID Card</b> .
Kickstart your studies with a range of <b>free short courses</b> to help develop your academic skills, or download <b>The Learning Centre workbooks</b> if studying off campus.
Log into your <b>JCU Student Email</b> account and check messages regularly. Contact <b>IT Help Desk</b> if you have any technical issues.
Investigate <b>scholarship</b> options at JCU and check to see if you are eligible to apply.
Complete the <b>JCU Respect</b> module in <b>LearnJCU</b> and visit the JCU <b>Safety and Wellbeing</b> website to find out more about the university's commitment to providing a safe and welcoming learning environment.
Complete the <b>Coursework Academic Integrity Education</b> modules in <b>LearnJCU</b> and pledge your commitment to produce original work with honesty and acknowledgement, avoiding academic misconduct.
Download the <b>Student Support Services Directory</b> to have free support service information at your fingertips.
